





Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God.





What color are the priest's vestments? We are still celebrating the Christmas season, so he is wearing white.



The Magi saw a star rise over Bethlehem and followed it to visit baby Jesus. They brought Him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.




Today we remember Jesus' baptism. Ask your family to tell you about your baptism.



A monk named Saint Basil though up a plan to help people who were being robbed.



Saint Basil didn't know how to give all the oney to the right people, so he baked a cake with the jewels baked inside.


Everyone shared the cake and got to keep the jewels from their slide. Yuml








