Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton

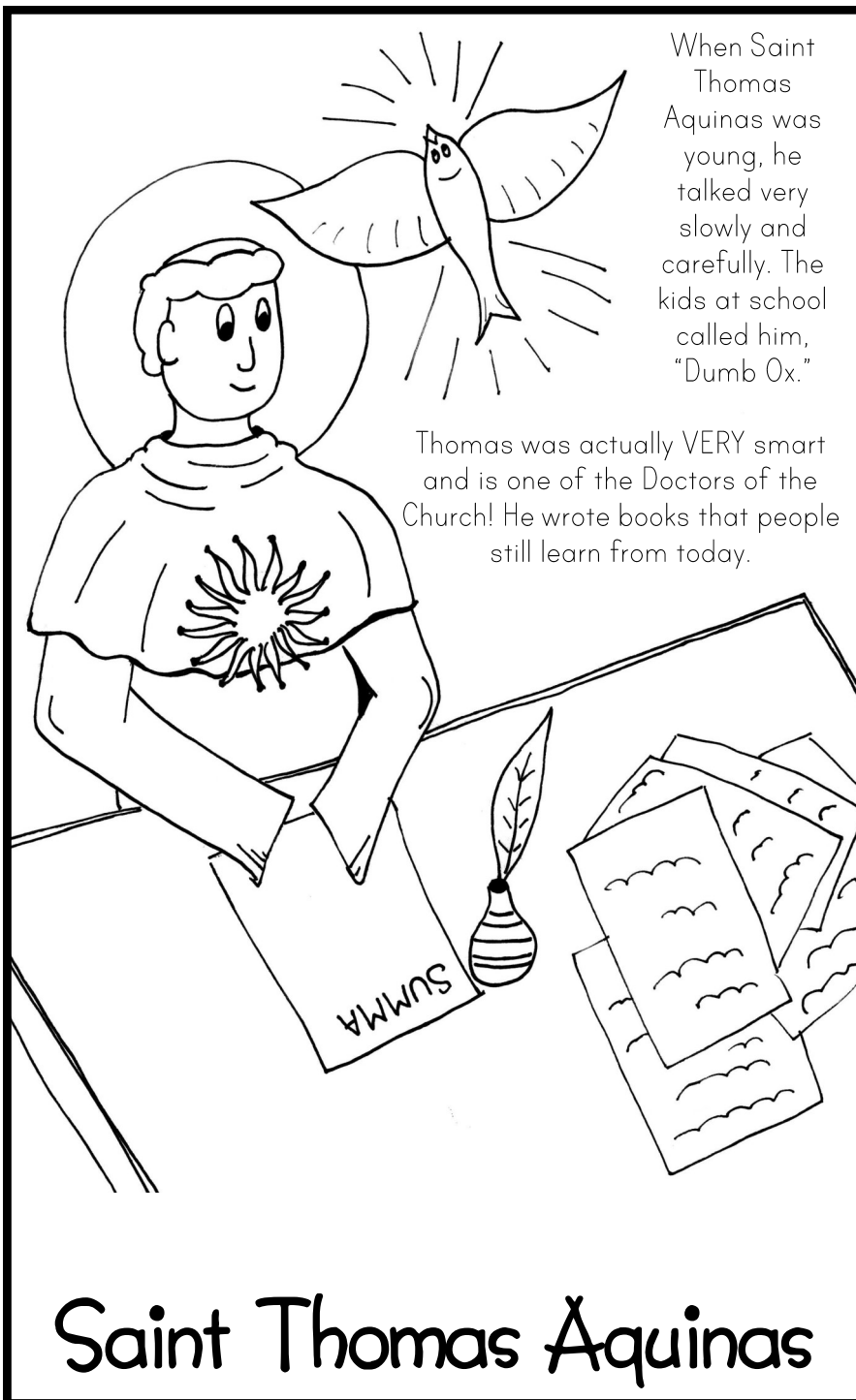
Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton lived in America. She helped start Catholic Schools to teach kids about God. Where do you learn about God?

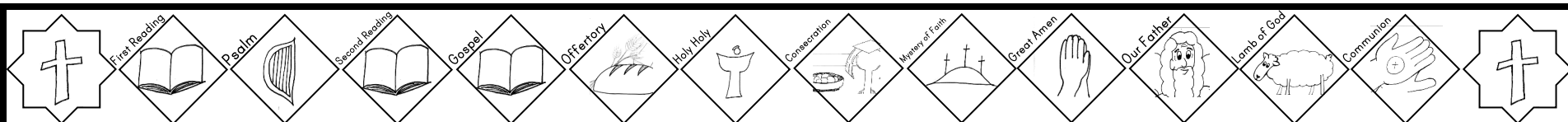
Saint Basil the Great

A monk named Saint Basil thought up a plan to help people who were being robbed.

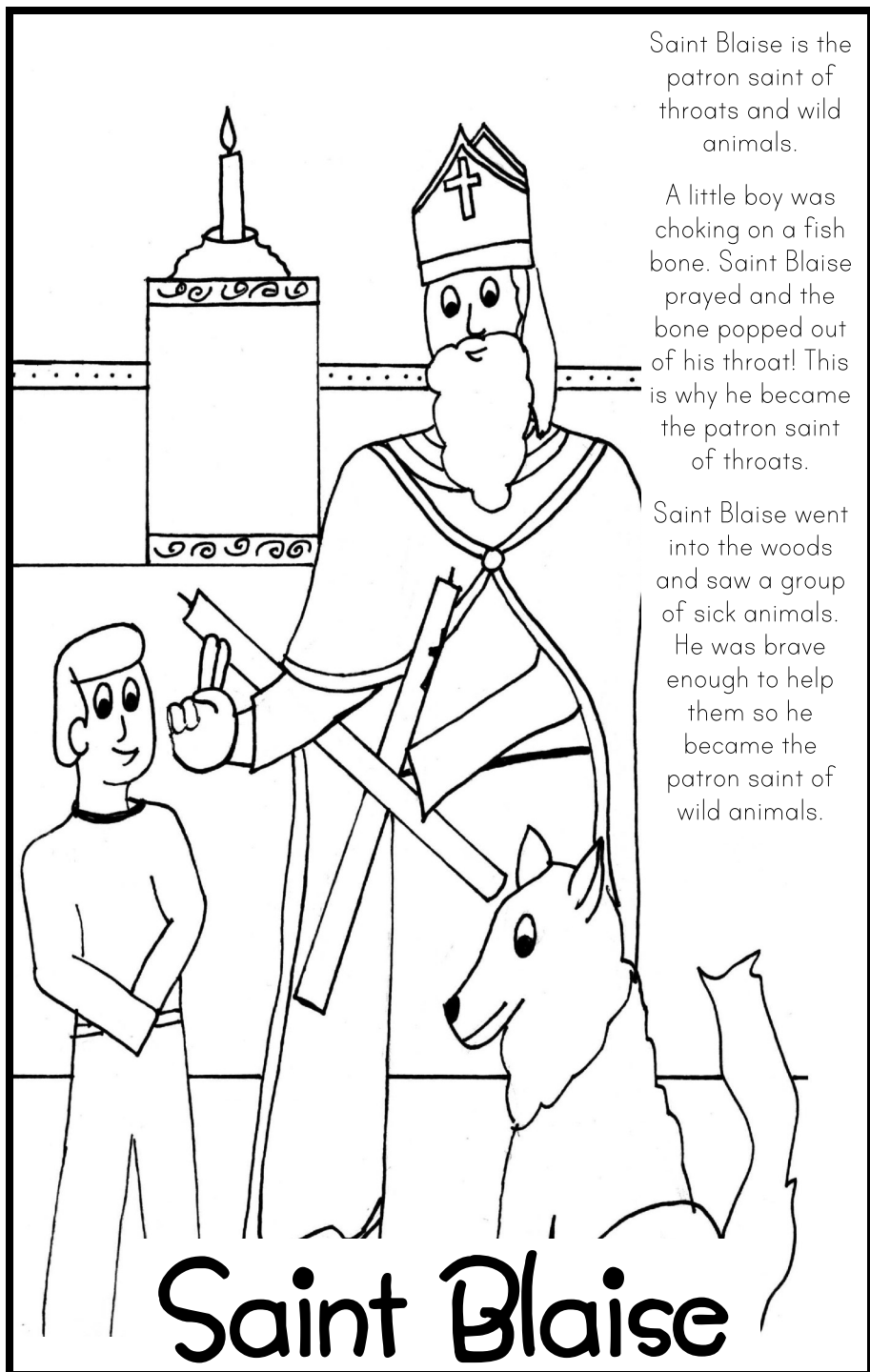

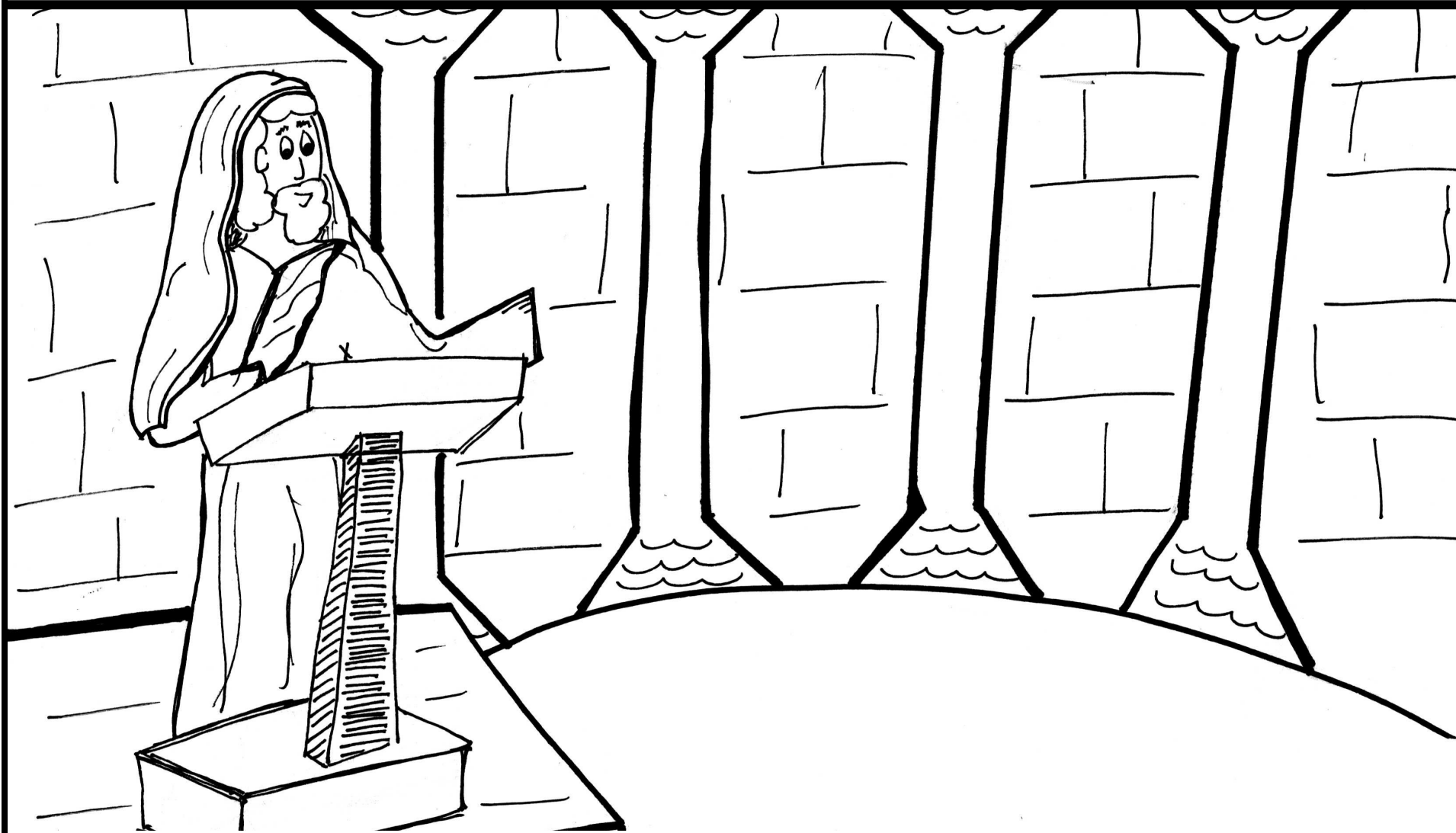
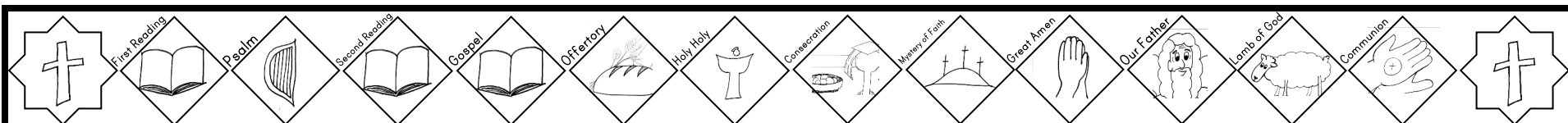
