The readings at church are organized in a book called the **Lectionary**.



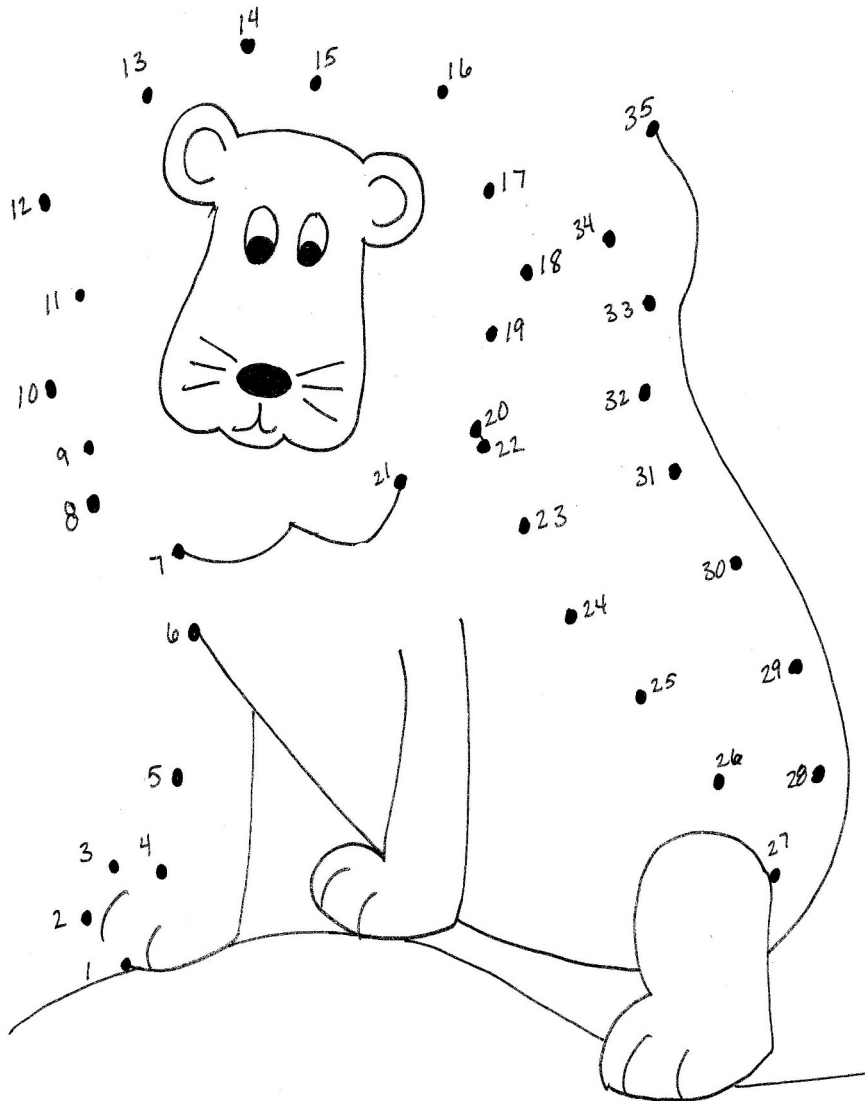
